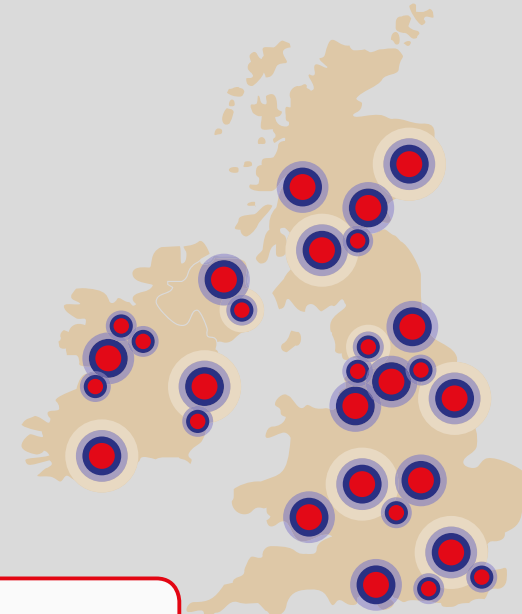




# Our impact over time
